Class 1A: The pony Club Walk and Trot 2022 Test **MUST BE LED**

Class 1B: The Pony Club Walk and Trot 2022 test combined training Bottom hole **Must BE LED.**

Class 2A: The pony Club Walk and Trot 2013 Test, **MAY BE ASSISTED BUT NOT LED.** 12 years & under on 1st January 2024

Class 2B: The Pony Club Walk and Trot 2013 test combined training, show jumping: 50cm max. **MAY BE ASSISTED BUT NOT LED.** 12 years & under on 1st January 2024

Class 3A: The pony Club preliminary PC70 2022. Riders 14 years & under on 1st January 2024

Class 3B: The pony Club preliminary PC70 2022 Test Combined Training. Show Jumping: 70cm max. Riders 14 years & under on 1st January 2024.

Class 4A: Pony Club Grassroots Dressage Test PC 80 2018. Riders any age.

Class 4B: Pony Club Grassroots Dressage Test PC 80 2018 Combined Training, Show Jumping: 80cm max. Riders any age.

Class 5A: Pony Club Novice Dressage Test 2020. Riders any age.

Class 5B: Pony Club PC90 Eventing Championship test 2015 Combined Training, Show Jumping: 90cm max. Riders any age.

Class 6A: Pony Club Intermediate dressage test 2024. Riders any age.

Class 6B: Pony Club PC100 Eventing Championship test 2013. Combined Training. Show Jumping: 100cm max. Riders any age.

Rules & conditions

1. Combined Training classes will be run under Pony Club rules for Dressage with Show Jumping Competitions 2024. The pure dressage classes will be run under Pony Club Dressage rules 2024.
2. Entries to reach the secretary by 22nd May. No late entries accepted
3. Dressage times will be posted on the east Kent Hunt Pony Club website from the 29th May and on PC results .Commanders are permitted in all classes.
4. Rosettes to 6th place in all classes
5. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organiser, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible. Neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the pony club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or any other way whatsoever.
6. In the event of cancellation 15% of the entry fee per competitor will be retained
7. No stallions, all horses must be 5 years old on the day of the event.
8. Any objections are to be made at the secretary's tent within 30 minutes of the alleged incident accompanied by a deposit of £10. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld; if the objection is dismissed the deposit will be retained.
9. Everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not must wear protection headgear that complies with the Pony club hat rules 2024
10. Please take all litter home with you and please DO NOT muck out horseboxes on the showground.
11. No dogs allowed on the showground.
12. OPEN TO NON PONY CLUB MEMBERS, but they must have adequate insurance cover. The East Kent Hunt Branch of the Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
13. The organisers' reserve the right to cancel any class, amalgamate sections where there are insufficient entries or split classes if oversubscribed.
14. **Health and Safety:** the organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health, safety and welfare of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid & prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
15. **Photographic Rights** – competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.

16. A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials. Vaccinations must be in accordance with the current Pony Club vaccination rules 2024 – please refer to the website.
